

Golden Safety Rules when using agrochemicals

1. Remember Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

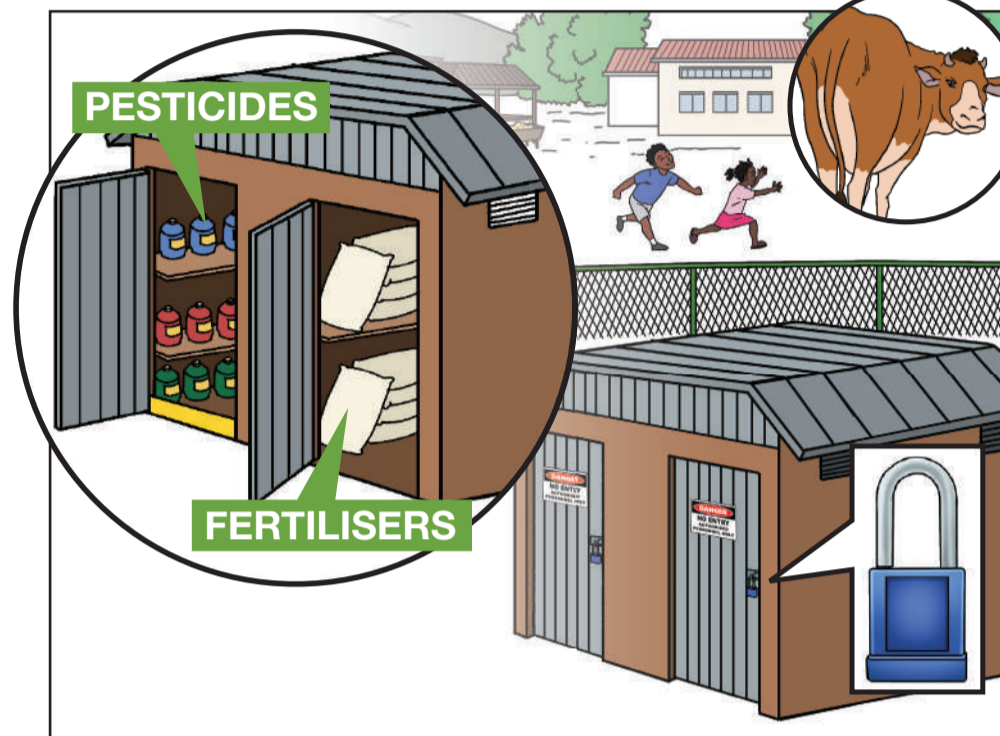
• Always wear your PPE

• Make sure it is clean and in good condition



2. Store agrochemicals correctly

- Out of reach of unauthorised personnel.
- In their original packaging, make sure openings are secure.
- Store in a well-ventilated, locked room away from food, fertilisers and livestock.



3. Do not handle if you are pregnant, breast feeding, sick or weak.



4. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using agrochemicals.



5. Do not spray when there are people nearby or in bad weather.

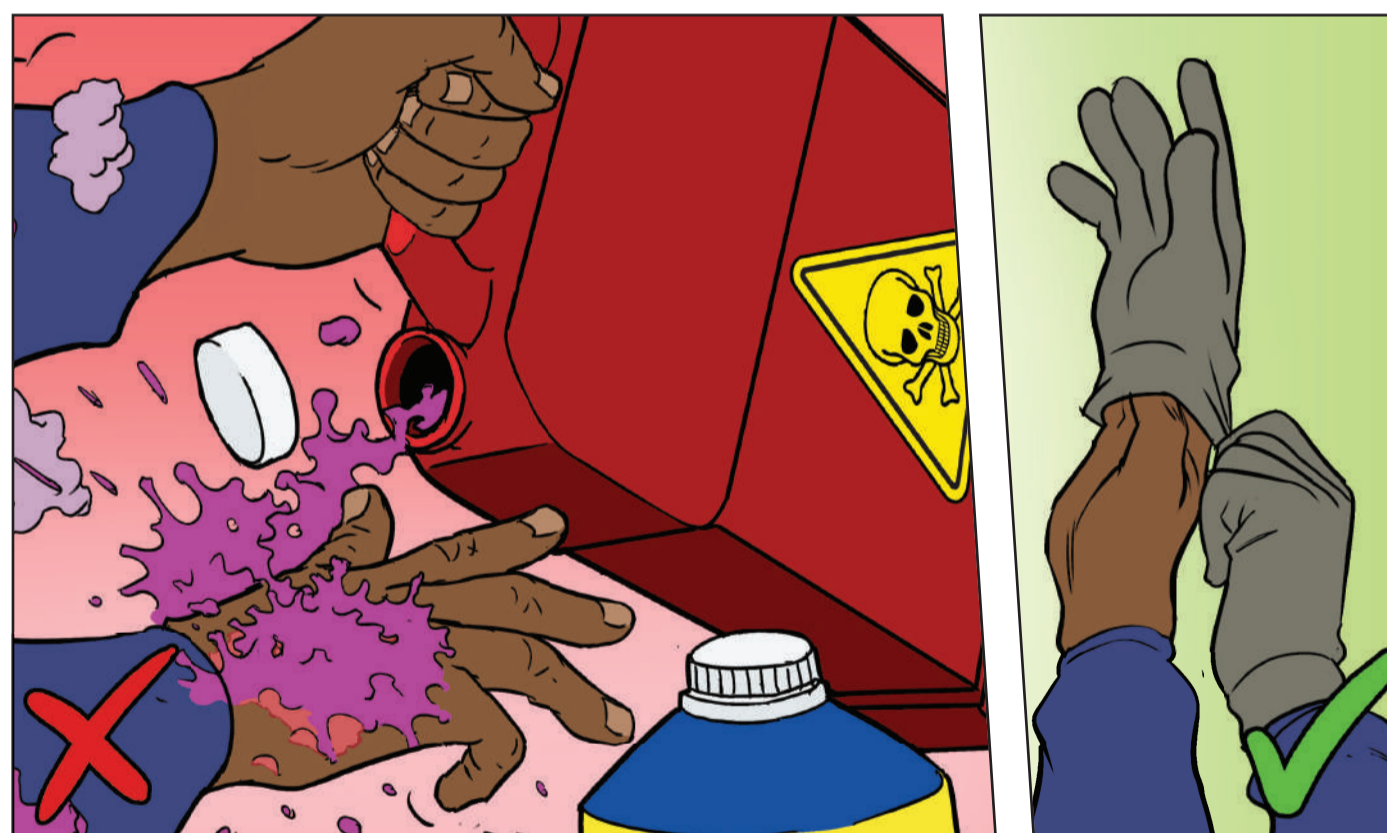
Do not spray when it is raining, windy or too hot (midday).



Remember, agrochemicals are dangerous to you!



6. Avoid all contact with skin.



In case of contact with skin or eyes:

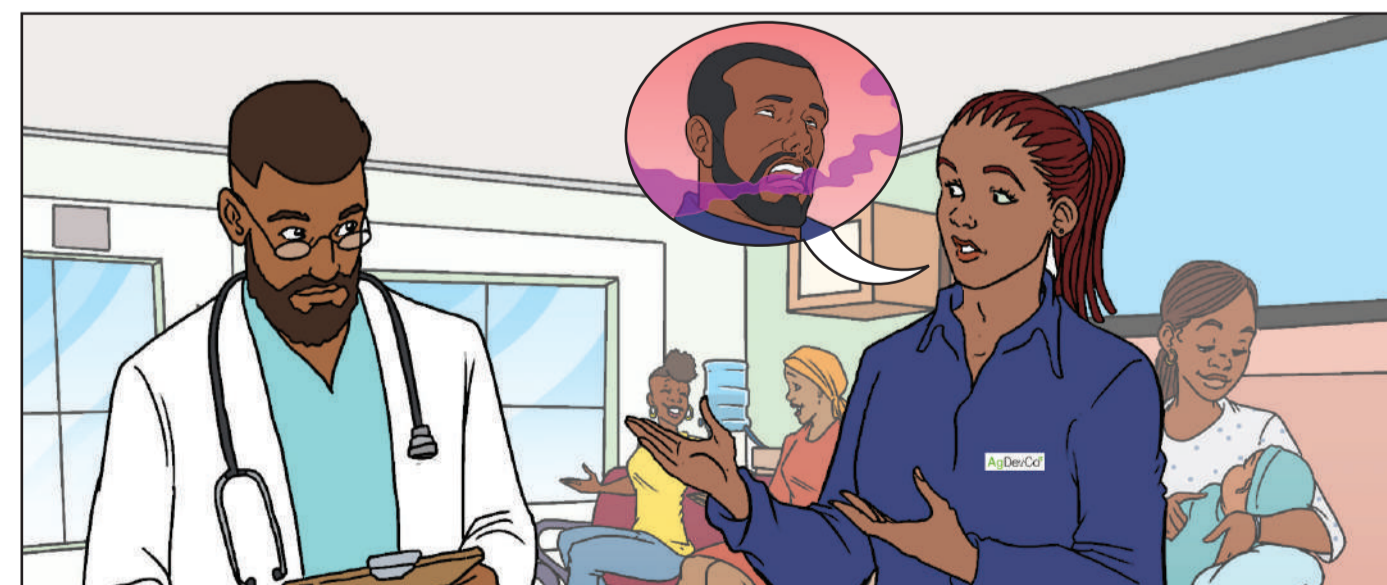
1. Rinse the area with clean water.
2. Go to a doctor as quickly as possible.



7. Do not swallow or inhale (breathe in). It can kill you!



In case of emergency, see a doctor immediately.



Agrochemicals are dangerous for the environment



8. Avoid any spills in nature or waterways. Do not mix or spray near water sources.

Clean equipment, PPE and empty containers away from water sources.



9. Triple rinse, puncture and dispose in a designated area.
